Thomas Smith served in the War of 1812 as Ensign of the 21st Virginia Militia under Captain Thomas Cary's Company, of Gloucester.

Thomas Robinson Yeatman served in the War of 1812 as an Ensign in the 115th VMR, served in Captain John Armistead, Mounted Infantry Company.

Armistead Smith served in the Revolutionary War by giving material aid to cause and was a Reverend in the Ware Episcopal Church.

Thomas Muse Yeatman served in the Revolution as a Lieutenant, commanded a company in Westmoreland County, also gave material aid to cause.
